1. Purpose of the International Invitation to tender

Under the joint Programme with AFD/KFW, the Ministry of Public Health has initiated an extensive programme of rehabilitation and equipment of health facilities in the ten regions of the country.

The first phase of this big programme concerns the Far North, the North, Adamaoua and South regions. This program is supported by AFD and KFW funds.

The Assisting Consultant to the Project owner, in associated consultancies comprising Consulting Engineers Salzgitter GmbH (CES), CONSEIL SANTE (CS) and GENEX will be responsible for its implementation. The aim of the programme is the improvement of availability of quality healthcare services through the rehabilitation and further development of health infrastructure and equipment to reach the millennium development goals (4 and 5) relating to maternal and child health.

In this light, The Minister of Public Contracts, Contracting Authority, hereby launches, on behalf of the Minister of Public Health, an open International invitation to tender to carry out the rehabilitation of infrastructure of some health facilities in the Adamaoua and South Region of Cameroon.

2. Description of works

Construction works for this tender file shall comprise of:

- The rehabilitation/extension of the existing buildings;

- The construction of new buildings including maternities, operating theatres , lodging for health personnel etc. ;
- The construction of auxiliary structures: annexes that shall include incineration pits, gutters, etc.

3. Execution deadline

The maximum execution deadline provided for by the Project Owner for the execution of the works for each batch shall be as follow:.

4. Participation

Participation in this invitation to tender is open on equal conditions to the national or international companies group having good understanding of civil engineering (building construction and rehabilitation of infrastructure).

Participation of Associated undertakings is permitted only if the representative is appointed.

5. Funding

The carrying out of the rehabilitation of infrastructure of some Health Facilities is financed by KfW (BMZ N°: 2006 66 172) and C2D (according to Financial Agreement CCM 6016 01 L between AFD and the Republic of Cameroon).

6. Bid bonds

Each bidder shall enclose to his bid, a bid bond whose value shall correspond to the batch as specified below. This bid bond shall be issued by a first-ranking banking institution approved by the Ministry in charge of Finance as on the list presented in section 12 of this tender file. The bid bond shall remain valid, thirty days after the expiry date of the bid. The amounts are fixed as follows:

8. Acquisition of tender file

9. Submission of bids

10. Admissibility of bids

The administrative documents required shall be produced in originals or true copies certified by the relevant services, and in accordance with the Special Rules and Regulations of the invitation to tender; otherwise the bid shall be rejected. They shall not be older than three (3) months and shall not be produced after the signing of the tender file.

Any bid not in conformity with the prescriptions of this notice and tender file shall be declared inadmissible. Especially, the absence of a bid bond issued by a first-rate bank approved by the Ministry in charge of Finance or the non-respect of the models of the tender file documents shall lead to the rejection of the bid outright without further appeal.

11. Opening of bids

Bids (*Administrative documents, technical and financial bids*) shall be opened in one session on **23 MAR. 2016** at **11.00 am.**, local time, by the Central Tenders Board for Works on Buildings and Public Utilities of the Ministry of Public Contracts in the conference room located in the building housing the headquarters of this Ministry in Yaoundé (former USAID), in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives with right proof of their mandate.

12. Evaluation criteria

Evaluation will be in accordance with the said criteria playoffs, then according to the criteria considered essential in the binary system (yes or no).

a. Eliminary criteria

- 1) Incomplete administrative file and/or Presence of forged documents in the bid document
- 2) Omission of more than five quantified unit prices in the Price Schedule or existence of more than one Price Schedule per batch
- 3) Absence of at least two (02) contracts of at least 100 millions FCFA each for the batches 4AD/SU-1, 4AD/SU-3, 4AD/SU- 5 et 4AD/SU-6 or absence of at least two (02) contract(s) of at least 75 millions FCFA each for other batches with relevant report (Procès-verbal), designed to achieve the company works in the field of building construction / rehabilitation within ten (10) years.
- 4) Presence of one (01) Works supervisor per batch solicited. He is either a Civil Engineer (\geq Bac+3), Civil or Rural Engineering senior technician (\geq Bac+2) with 10 years minimum experience.
- 5) Average turnover for the last five years (, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015) less than 50% of the estimated budget for the batch chosen; NB: The average turnover will be based on the number of the years of existence for those with less than five years' activity
- 6) Absence of attestation of Financial capacity or attestation of solvency established by first ranking institution with an amount less than 50% of the estimated budget for the batch chosen;
- 7) Lack of the signed Declaration of Commitment



Essential criteria (10 items)

- Specific references of the company (01 item);
- Declaration and report of site visit (01 item);
- Attestation of financial capacity of the company (01 item);
- Number and qualification of site personnel (04 items);
- Equipment of Company (01 item);
- Organization, methodology, and work schedule (02 items).

N.B : Only tenders that have obtained at least seven "yes" on the 10 essential criteria above will be qualified for the financial evaluation.

13. Award of contract

A bidder can submit for more than one lot, but can be awarded at most two (02) lots. If the bidder has the lowest bid in more than two lots, contracts will be awarded to him in the order he has indicated in his submission, but he shall have a separate staff for each lot, sufficient materials / logistics means for the simultaneous achievement of these lots. Each lot awarded will constitute a separate contract.

14. Validity of bids

Bidders will remain committed to their bids for ninety (90) days from the deadline set for the submission of tenders.
